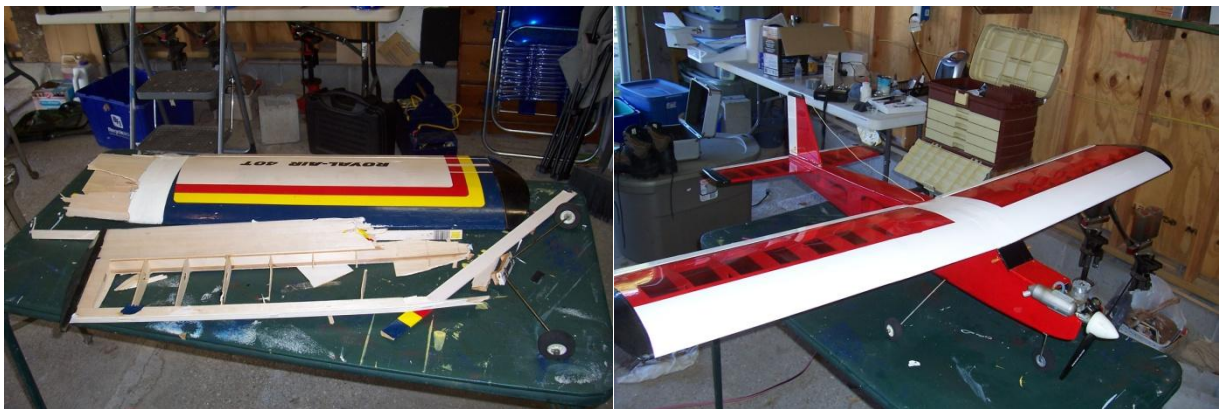
From your editor: Chris Bobek
